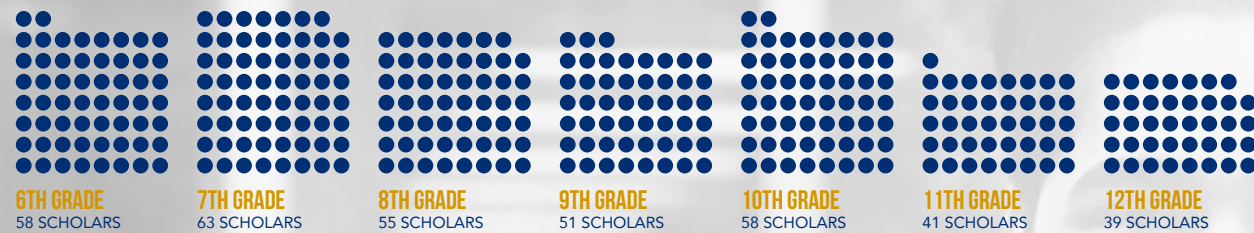
# OUR MISSION

The mission of *The Collegiate School of Memphis* is to prepare young ladies and gentlemen for college success within a highly structured, nurturing, Christian environment.

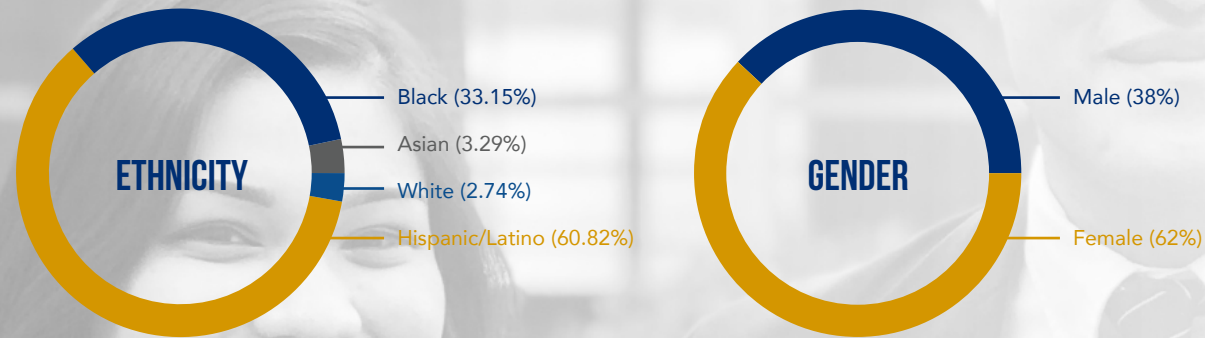

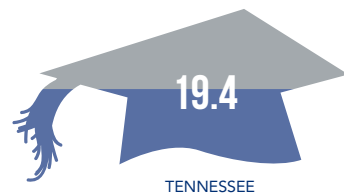

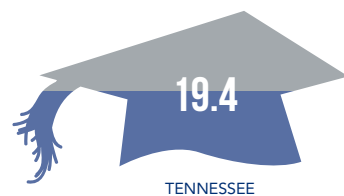
